SPECIAL SALARY ADJUSTMENT

R02 AND E97

Effective August 1, 2021, eligible employees in Ranges C and N whose current salary rate is between \$7,323 and \$7,975 in the following classes shall receive a one-time Special Salary Adjustment (SSA) to the salary of \$7,976, including employees who separated from state service prior to August 1, 2021, and have lump sum payments that extend beyond August 1, 2021. The lump sum payments shall be adjusted to reflect the salary increase.

Employees hired on or after August 2, 2021, are not eligible to receive the one-time SSA.

The SSA will not change the Merit Salary Adjustment date.
