**SPECIAL SALARY ADJUSTMENTS**

**M16 AND M17**

**CLASSES**

Effective July 1, 2022, pursuant to the Receiver's salary setting authority granted in Marciano Plata et al., v. Arnold Schwarzenegger, et al., case number C01-1351 TEH, the following classes shall have the salary range increased.

**EMPLOYEES**

Effective July 1, 2022, all employees designated M16 and M17 in the above classes who are below the new minimum, shall receive the new minimum salary rate (based on 599.673 – entrance Rate), including employees who separated from state service and have lump sum payments that extend beyond July 1, 2022. The lump sum payments shall be adjusted to reflect the above increase.

**DOCUMENTATION:**

Departments will be responsible for keying SAL transactions effective July 1, 2022, for eligible employees and correct any resulting out-of-sequence transactions.

Employees who separated from state service prior to July 1, 2022, and have lump sum payments that extend beyond July 1, 2022, departments shall adjust their lump sum to reflect the above salary changes.

**SECTION 5: HIRING-ABOVE-MINIMUM AUTHORIZATION**

- M16 class code 8239 and M17 class code 8241 are updated. (Effective 07/01/22)

**DOCUMENTATION:**

Departments must key a SAL effective 07/01/2022 for eligible employees with a HAM plus salary and correct any resulting out-of-sequence transactions.
