**SECTION 02: KEY TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING IDENTIFIER CODES USED IN PAY

- State Controller's Office
- California State Mediation and Conciliation Service
- State Athletic Commission

DOCUMENTATION:

Departments who receive transactions results with error message 0126-13 "EE NOT IN EXCLUDED AGENCY HAS CBID "E" BUT PS CBID-DESIG IS NOT" E" must submit PAR package to SCO for keying. A system change is forthcoming, SCO will provide an update at that time.

EMPLOYEE MOVEMENT INSTRUCTIONS:

All employees currently receiving the salary rate in Range A shall move to the new monthly Range J and receive the 6.25-percent salary increase and retain their salary anniversary date.

DOCUMENTATION:

Departments must key a 335 transaction effective 06/26/23 to assign eligible employees to new applicable range, based on Alternated Range Criteria 496. Any employees that are moving to Range J should have their salaries adjusted accordingly, and any out of sequence transactions will also need to be corrected.
